- Conduct data analysis, and regular audits on material, stock discrepancies, shortages, and material quality issues.
- Lead continuous improvement activities to enhance material data collection, streamline material flow processes, improve stock visibility and traceability throughout manufacturing, and identify and implement opportunities for automation.
- Coordinate closely with departments to forecast material supply and ensure timely material availability.
- Monitor and maintain optimal inventory levels of raw materials and finished goods to support production schedules while minimizing shortages and excess stock.
- Coordinate the receiving, inspection and verification of all incoming materials to ensure quality, conformity and accuracy.
- Develop and implement incoming material inspection procedures and quality control measures to assess and improve supplier performance.
